

Bartlett/Jackson Recycling Center and Transfer Station
GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bartlett/Jackson Recycling Center and Transfer Station is located on Route 16, just north of Storyland on the Bartlett/Jackson town line. The hours of operation are from Noon until 6 PM Monday, Tuesday, and Friday thru Sunday. They are closed on Wednesday and Thursday. These hours apply to all days except Christmas day when they are closed. Closed Christmas eve at 04:00 PM.

Transfer Station stickers are mandatory and must be on your vehicle. These stickers can be obtained thru the Town Clerk-Tax Collector Office during normal business hours. They can also be obtained by submitting a transfer station sticker request form located on the office door and sent with a self-addressed stamped envelope. Hart's residents are allowed 2 stickers per property (no matter how many vehicles are registered.) If you have more than 2 vehicles you may choose which 2 to take to the transfer station.

Items to be Recycled:

Glass - All food and beverage glass bottles and jars. Wash food residue out of all containers.

Aluminum beverage cans – All beer and soda cans only. Make sure all containers are clean and empty. Put in window #8.

Tin/Steel/Bi-metals cans and empty aerosol cans, also aluminum food tins - Please wash.

Plastics – All food beverage plastics with recycling numbers 1-7. These numbers may be found inside the chasing arrows. Please remove the caps to any containers and to rinse the containers.

Florescent Light Bulbs – All mercury containing devices must be removed and has to be kept separate. Ballasts are also to be removed and recycled separately.

Paper - Magazines, window envelopes, shredded paper in non plastic bags, cereal boxes, and beer boxes goes in window #6. Newspapers & inserts (not bundled) go in window #7. (No window envelopes or shredded paper) Office paper in designated containers.

Corrugated cardboard – all boxes except cereal/detergent/pizza boxes. Flatten cardboard boxes. No Aseptic boxes, no juice boxes, milk cartons, broth boxes, etc. (these go in the trash)

Scrap metal – All metal items including car parts, appliances, metal roofing. We **DO NOT** accept whole cars.

Used Motor Oil – Please include **only** used motor oil. Oil in jugs or bottles only. Commercial generators should call about disposal. Please label “used oil for recycling”. Straight oil only. Absolutely **no** anti freeze.

Motor Vehicle Batteries – All wet-cell batteries from cars, trucks, motorcycles, etc. Use caution handling batteries. Place in designated area.

Rechargeable Batteries – All rechargeable batteries must be recycle; including lithium, alkaline, hearing aid, etc.

Brush and Unpainted/Untreated Wood – Brush up to 5” in diameter and unpainted/untreated lumber. Materials may be taken to the brush burning area **only** after checking with attendant. No nails or screws.

Leaf & Yard Waste –Clean – empty all containers and bags.



Household Hazardous Waste (Including oil based paints, oven cleaners, insecticides, herbicides, solvents, and other poisons) are **NOT** accepted at the facility during the year. Hart's Location Residents are eligible to participate annually in a Household Hazardous Waste collection day. Please store materials safely at your home until collection day.
